My summer holidays	Autumn 1	Grammar focus: past tense regular and high-frequency irregular verbs (preterite) Vocabulary focus: Holiday activities, modes of transport, the weather, booking a hotel Phonics focus: recall of all SSCs taught in Y7 - focus on importance of tilde in Spanish Cultural focus: travelling in South America	This term we focus on the introduction of the past simple for talking about specific times in the past through the topic of recent holiday activities while revisiting high-frequency verbs and vocabulary as previously seen in Y7	English Geography
Around town	Autumn 2	Grammar focus: comparatives and superlatives, present tense, past tense (preterite) imperative phrases, prepositions of place Vocabulary focus: Town and local area, opinions, directions Phonics focus: recall of all SSCs taught to date - focus on importance of tilde in Spanish Cultural focus: comparisons of towns in Spanish speaking countries with the UK, The Day of the Dead	Here we shift our focus to the topic of local area. We revisit how to effectively express and justify a range of different opinions, including the use of comparisons and superlatives. We revisit previously studied tenses to reinforce students' understanding of how to use and adapt these to a range of different topics. We also further practise transactional language in asking for and giving directions.	English Geography
Sports	Spring 1	Grammar focus: stem-changing verbs in the present tense, the past tense (preterite), the near future Vocabulary focus: Sports, time-frames Phonics focus: recall of all SSCs taught to date - focus on importance of tilde in Spanish /v/ Cultural focus: sports specific to Spain	This term builds on students' learning from Y7 Summer 1 to revisit the topic of free time, and specifically different sports. During this term we revisit high frequency verbs in the present tense (looking in greater detail at Spanish stem-changing verbs) before then revisiting the rules for the formation and use of the past tense as seen in the Autumn term.
