Splash School is an engaging, hands-on water safety programme designed to build confidence, resilience and essential life skills. Learners will take part in beach-based activities, interactive learning sessions, team challenges and structured aquatic confidence activities led by qualified coastal safety educators.

The day follows the SPLASH framework:

- Study – interactive water safety learning
- Play – beach challenges and teamwork
- Lunch – a two-course seaside meal
- Aquatic Skills – structured ocean confidence sessions
- Slurping Summary – hot chocolate and reflection
- Home – return with new skills and memories

- Swimwear
- Towel
- Warm change of clothes
- Coat and suitable footwear
