We are excited to invite Year 11 students back into school for GCSE Results Day on Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> August 2026.

On Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> August 2026, the school will be open from 9:00am until 11:00am for students to collect their results. Parents and Carers are more than welcome to attend with their child. These results will be issued in the form of a results slip, with final GCSE certificates available for collection later in the year.

Upon arriving at school, students should make their way to the results collection desks, which will be in the reception area. Various members of staff, including the Senior Leadership Team and Heads of Department, will be available to support students and answer any questions they may have.

Students should make every effort to collect their results in person on 20<sup>th</sup> August, however, we recognise that this may not be possible for everyone. If your child is unable to attend, they must nominate someone else to collect their results on their behalf, such as a parent or carer. This form must be completed and brought to school on Results Day, along with photographic ID for the nominated person collecting the results. This form is also available to be collected from Reception during school hours.

Please note that we do not, under any circumstances, provide exam results over the telephone.
